

## SWRC-notification Topics Selections

All subscribers of our [swrc-notification@lists.nasa.gov](mailto:swrc-notification@lists.nasa.gov) now have the option to select which notification types they are interested in receiving.

1. Go to <https://lists.nasa.gov/mailman/options/swrc-notification>
2. Login with your email and password.
3. If you have forgotten your password, type in your email and press 'Remind' button.

In order to change your membership option, you must first log in by giving your email address and membership password in the section below. If you don't remember your membership password, you can have it emailed to you by clicking on the button below. If you just want to unsubscribe from this list, click on the *Unsubscribe* button and a confirmation message will be sent to you.

**Important:** From this point on, you must have cookies enabled in your browser, otherwise none of your changes will take effect.

**Unsubscribe**

By clicking on the *Unsubscribe* button, a confirmation message will be emailed to you. This message will have a link that you should click on to complete the removal process (you can also confirm by email; see the instructions in the confirmation message).

**Password reminder**

By clicking on the *Remind* button, your password will be emailed to you.

4. You will receive an email with your password. Use that password to log into the page.
5. Once login, if you prefer, you can change your default password to something that you can remember.
6. Under 'your subscription options', you should see the question 'Which topic categories would you like to subscribe to?' By default, none of the check box would be checked meaning that you should be getting all the messages from the mailing list. If you are only interested in getting certain types of messages, you can select the topic categories here.

**Which topic categories would you like to subscribe to?**

By selecting one or more topics, you can filter the traffic on the mailing list, so as to receive only a subset of the messages. If a message matches one of your selected topics, then you will get the message, otherwise you will not. If a message does not match any topic, the delivery rule depends on the setting of the option below. If you do not select any topics of interest, you will get all the messages sent to the mailing list.

**Do you want to receive messages that do not match any topic filter?**

This option only takes effect if you've subscribed to at least one topic above. It describes what the default delivery rule is for messages that don't match any topic filter. Selecting *No* says that if the message does not match any topic filters, then you won't get the message, while selecting *Yes* says to deliver such non-matching messages to you.

If no topics of interest are selected above, then you will receive every message sent to the mailing list.

**Avoid duplicate copies of messages?**

When you are listed explicitly in the *To:* or *cc:* headers of a list message, you can opt to not receive another copy from the mailing list. Select *Yes* to avoid receiving copies from the mailing list; select *No* to receive copies.

If the list has member personalized messages enabled, and you elect to receive copies, every copy will have a *X-Mailman-Copy: yes* header added to it.

7. For the question, 'Do you want to receive messages that do you match any topic filter?' Select 'Yes' here since we do send messages like general announcements that do not match any of the defined topic categories.
